The Girard - Format and Rules

A. FORMATION OF FLIGHTS

This is a 3-day tournament according to flights. Teams are in flight by combined team handicaps. The six lowest combined handicaps form Flight #1. The second lowest six comprise Flight #2, and so on, until all flights are formed. If two teams are of equal handicap, the lower combined team index will be in the lower flight.

B. FORMAT OF THE TOURNAMENT

Five 9-hole matches playing better ball of partners. Each team, playing net better ball of partners, competes against every team in its own flight in a 9-hole match. One 9-hole match is played on Thursday, May 5th. Two 9-hole matches are played on Friday, May 6th. Two 9-hole matches are played on Saturday, May 7th. The team earn-ing the most points in each flight will qualify for the "Championship Shootout" to determine the overall champion.

C. SCORING

The format of each match will be the net better ball of one team versus the net better ball of the opposing team on a hole-by-hole basis. A players' handicap will be reduced based on the low handicap player in each match. The low handicap player in each match will always play at scratch or zero handicap.

10-Point Scoring System

- · Each hole will be worth one point
- · Team winning a hole will be awarded one point
- · A hole that results in a tie will yield each team a half point
- The team with the most points wins the match and is awarded an additional bonus point
- A match that results in a tie will yield an additional half point to each team
- FLIGHT WINNER WILL BE THE TEAM THAT ACCUMULATES THE MOST POINTS OVER FIVE MATCHES

The Girard - Format and Rules

D. HANDICAPS

Players lowest handicap index of the previous twelve months will prevail. There can be no more than a ten-stroke differential between partners. The committee reserves the right to adjust handicaps before or during the competition.

E. RULES OF PLAY

USGA Rules will govern all play except where modified by Woodland Hills Country Club local rules or the Tournament Rules listed in this booklet. **Match Play rules apply throughout the tournament.**

F. TEES

Flights 1 thru 5 will play the blue tees. Flights 6 thru 10 will play the white tees.

G. INCOMPLETE FLIGHTS/NO SHOWS

If a Flight does not consist of six teams at the start of the competition, each team will play one match against net par. A marker will play with the team.

If a team withdraws from the event prior to the first match being played, the remaining teams in the flight will play the respective matches against net par. If after the beginning of the event a team withdraws, all points awarded to the other five teams in the flight go to five. A team can always play a match with only one of the team players.

H. WILD CARD

There will be two Wild Card teams that advance to the Championship Shootout. One from flights 1-5 and one from flights 6-10. The team with the highest point total that does not win its flight in both of those groups will advance to the Championship Shootout.

The Girard - Format and Rules

I. TIE BREAKS

Ties within each flight will be settled by the head-to-head result. If a tie remains, the points made in the fifth match will break the tie. The tie-breaker for the Wild Card will be the fifth match points.

J. ON-COURSE EVENTS

K. THE CHAMPIONSHIP SHOOTOUT

The winning teams along with the two Wild Card teams will compete in a two-man ALTERNATE SHOT format to determine the Overall Champion. The shootout for flights 1-5 will be played on holes 8, 9, and 10. The shootout for flights 6-9 will be played on holes 9, 10, and 11. Teams will be eliminated on each hole based on the highest net score. Any ties will be determined by a chip off. The two winning teams will meet to play hole 18 to determine the Overall Champion. If 18 is tied, play will move to hole 10, then back to 18 and so on, until a Champion is determined. Handicaps for the shootout will be calculated at the beginning of the shootout and given where they fall on the holes played, based on ratings.




