JOURNAMENT PACKAGE

Golf Packages Custom Created For Your Event

The price of the package will depend on your estimated player count and the date of your tournament.

JOURNAMENT PRICING

- Rate per player is \$70, includes green fee and cart, plus a \$20 Food and Beverage Minimum
- A \$2,000 nonrefundable deposit and a signed contract are required to secure any available Monday date
- Woodland Hills County Club requires a 65-player minimum for any golf event
- One "long hole" or 3-hole Putting Contest is \$200
- Donated Food and Beverage Fee \$250





JOURNAMENT FORMATS

Better Ball Twosome

Two people play as a team, taking handicaps as they fall on the card. Lowest score on the hole with handicap counts toward the team's better-ball score for round. Only the lowest score on the hole is counted. The team with the lowest 18-hole score wins.

Best Ball

This format may be played as two-, three-, or four-person teams. Golfers play their own ball on each hole, and the lowest score is recorded as the team score. This format may be played with or without a handicap. This is usually a fun format with a medium pace of play. Results can be calculated quickly.

Scramble

This format is probably the most enjoyable, because you use only the best tee shot, and the pace of play can be very fast. Each player hits a tee shot and the best one is selected. All players take their next shots from that point. This process is repeated until the ball is "holed out" and the team records a score. The winning team is the one that records the lowest 18-hole score. This format promotes easier and faster scoring.

Shamble

This format is also one the more enjoyable because, like a scramble, you use only the best tee shot and also get the opportunity to play your own ball.
